*Downtown Library Auditorium*

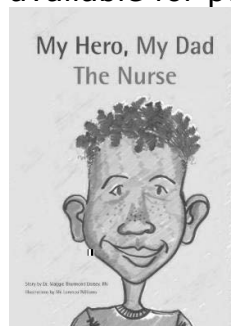
Doors open at 5:30 for
