Bill Baab had a sixty-year career with the Augusta Chronicle, first as a copy boy in 1955, rising to outdoor editor in 1964 retiring in 2000, but returning and retiring as fishing editor in 2022. Baab wrote for many sporting journals and produced a book on the famous angler George Perry, Remembering George W. Perry. A keen local historian and collector, Baab wrote Augusta on Glass: Drops of History from Glass and Pottery Containers Used by Soda Water Manufacturers, Whiskey Distillers, Beer Brewers, Mineral Water Sellers and Patent Medicine Men in and Around Augusta Georgia, Augusta on Glass: Drops of History from Many Druggists in Augusta Georgia from the 1830s through the 1930s, and Augusta on Glass: The Retail Dairies of Aiken Columbia and Richmond Counties.
