Agnes Dorothy Anderson was born on 8 October 1922 in Augusta, Richmond County, Georgia. She attending Tubman High School and graduated in 1938. She married Charles Franklin "Snookie" Snipes sometime between 1940-1942. She entered Barrett Nursing School at University Hospital on 29 September 1942 and was admitted to the WWII Cadet Nursing Corp on 1 July 1943. She graduated in 1945. Charles Snipes died tragically in a motorcycle accident in 27 May 1945. Dorothy later married Walter Jung. She died on 21 December 2005 and is buried in the family plot at Harlem Memorial Cemetery in Columbia County, Georgia.
