Administrative/Biographical: Donor unknown. Originally the property of Captain William Allen, a Revolutionary Soldier. After his death Major Beverly Allen came into possession of it. Following his death, it was passed to Dr. Beverly Allen Henry, the nephew of Mildred Beck, wife of Beverly Allen who had no offspring. After the death of Dr. Henry, his daughter, Mrs. Mildred Henry Elliot assumed ownership, later passing it on to John H. McIntosh, second great grandson of William Allen.
