Administrative/Biographical History: Unknown donor. The newsletters are addressed to James C. Moore, 1312 Milledge Road.

The promotional flyer was published by Cannonball Rail Excursions, a local outfit that offered stream train trips around the region during the 1960s and 70s. Local railroad enthusiast Georgia Weiss was president and promoter. This particular flyer advertised an excursion to Waynesboro and Macon on Saturday, June 22, 1968. According to the flyer, the trip was sponsored by the Southern Railway System and the Georgia-Carolina Rail Club.

The Cinder Snapper was published monthly by the Augusta Chapter National Railway Historical Society Inc., incorporated sometime in 1968 under the laws of the State of Georgia as a non-profit, tax exempt organization. Its first editor was Albert M. Langley Jr. The dates included are November/December 1968 – March 1969.

The Best Friend was a monthly publication of the Charleston Chapter of the National Railway Historical Society. The dates included are September 1967 – April 1968.
