E.H Pughe was a publisher in Augusta of the Daily News, a Republican newspaper, in 1866-1867 He remained with this paper, mainly as the publisher, through its various changes of masthead until it folded in 1869. Pughe established Pughe's City Directory in 1865, starting to advertise for advertisements and subscribers on September 1, 1865. The 1867 edition expanded to cover Hamburg, South Carolina as well as Augusta. At this time there is no evidence that more than these two issues were published. After the folding of the newspaper, Pughe remained in Augusta as a printer at least until 1872.

Conditions governing access: Restricted. Items are very fragile. Users are directed to other volumes in the City Directories collection held in the Georgia Room
