Mount Saint Joseph Academy was an all-girls Catholic school founded by the Sisters of St. Joseph in 1915. The school operated until 1960 when its students were merged with those of Boys Catholic High School to become Aquinas High School. The Order's convent stood on Monte Sano Avenue and is honored by a historical marker. Other Augusta, Georgia institutions founded by the Sisters of St. Joseph include Saint Mary's Elementary School, Aquinas High School, and St. Joseph's Hospital.
