Woodrow Wilson (December 28, 1856-February 3, 1924), 28<sup>th</sup> President of the United States spent his boyhood (1860-1870) here in Augusta at the Boyhood Home of Woodrow Wilson on 419 7<sup>th</sup> Street Augusta, GA. The Reverend Dr. Joseph R. Wilson, Wilson's was pastor of the 1<sup>st</sup> Presbyterian Church where the Centennial Observance was held.
