From March 10th to June 30th the Georgia Heritage Room will host the Rosa T. Beard Debutante Club Exhibit. So many historical pieces will be on display, including Rosa T. Beard's granddaughter's dress, Noel Corbin's favorite in the room. When asked what installing an exhibit in the Georgia Heritage Room meant to her, the PhD student of UGA exclaimed it was exciting.

"Ah man, it feels like I'm plugging in pieces of Augusta culture into a room so fitting to be called the Georgia [Heritage] Room," Noel Corbin, Contract Curator for the Lucy C. Laney Museum said.

On June 21st, the ARCPLS and the museum will collaborate once more for a day of exploration and celebration before the exhibition comes to a close. Stop by to explore the world of debutante and see history in fabric form, Monday through Friday 9am- 5pm at 823 Telfair Street.
